



In the family of Isidro Hanco Puma and Magarita Cjuro Huaman Rios live the children Janet (11 years), Beltran (8 years) and the small Anderson with just 4 months.

The family lives from agriculture, the Inca Trail and handicraft with all of the well-known problems. There is never enough money in the house to satisfy the needs of the family and especially to pay for the education of the children.

Isidro (on the right in the picture during our project presentation in Chupani) is currently president of the community. He is a very active president who doesn't shy from a confrontation with the political authorities and he listens to the advices of the teachers and Alipio. A couple of weeks ago he went to Cusco to complain about the mayor of Urubamba. The mayor had declared that the road to Chupani is completely finished and in perfect condition. Of course the reality is something completely different. The authorities in Cusco gave him a camera to take photos of the situation. Naturally the mayor of Urubamba is not really amused by that.



Only the family lives in his house as the animals do have a small stable for themselves. Unfortunately the health situation is only marginally improved by this and all of them suffer from the "classics".

They would like to improve the situation in the house and during our first visit we realized that there is hardly any daylight coming through the holes in the walls. We explained the advantages and necessity of a PET lamp and they were immediately interested. So we started with the preparations.



One part of the required material exists in the village (2,5l PET bottle, a piece of old metal) while the rest is cheap and sufficient for several families (chloral and silicon). The lamp was installed on the roof and it had an immediate positive effect as it became significantly lighter. The family was really enthusiastic and especially Margarita who said that now she could really see something while cooking!

Isidro and Margarita would like to learn something about the prevention and cure of the illnesses. At the moment they use traditional medicine based on teas made from medical herbs only. In the house they would like to have light during the night as well and hot water as the personal hygiene is far away from being adequate. As they are afraid of getting sick from the ice-cold water they avoid washing themselves as much as possible. There is a toilette at the side of the house which was built by the town but it doesn't work.

For their children they do want a good education so that they can work in a real profession and live in the town where the conditions are much better.
